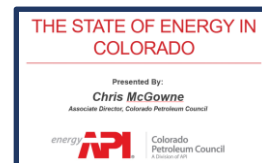

2019 Activities:

In 2019, the MHSRC held two luncheons/events. The first was in the Spring (30-May) and included a presentation and tour of the Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge. Many of you will remember that Shell Chemical produced agricultural chemicals at this site until 1982 and partnered with the US Army on a large environmental clean-up and restoration project.
